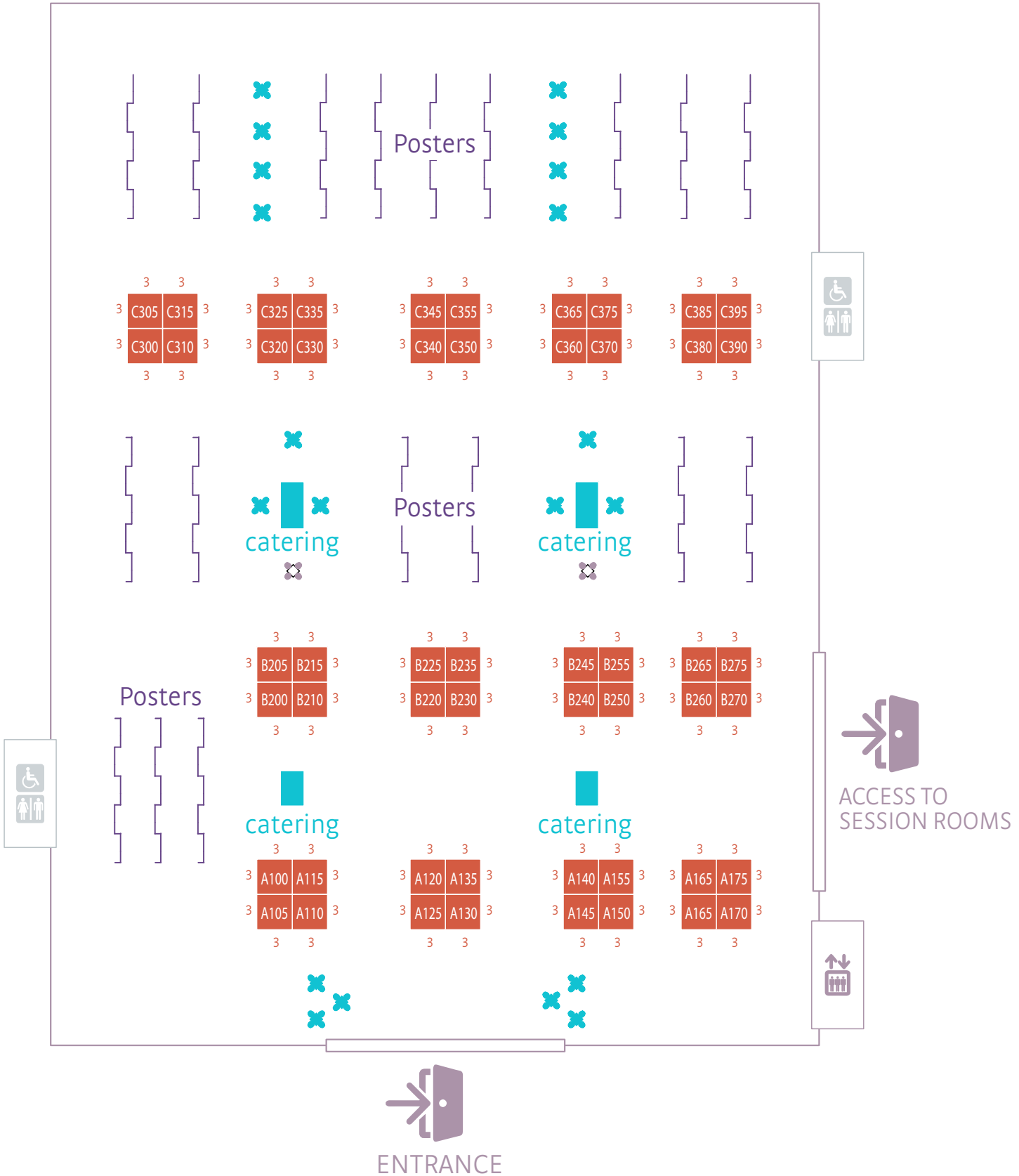

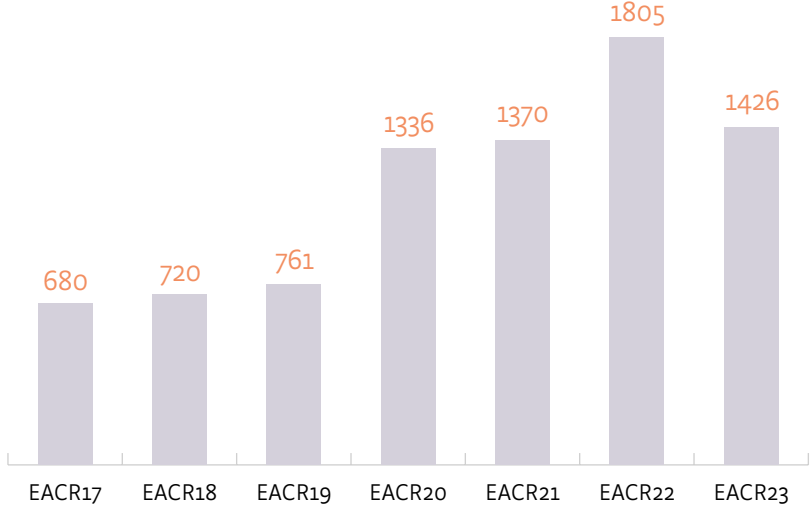

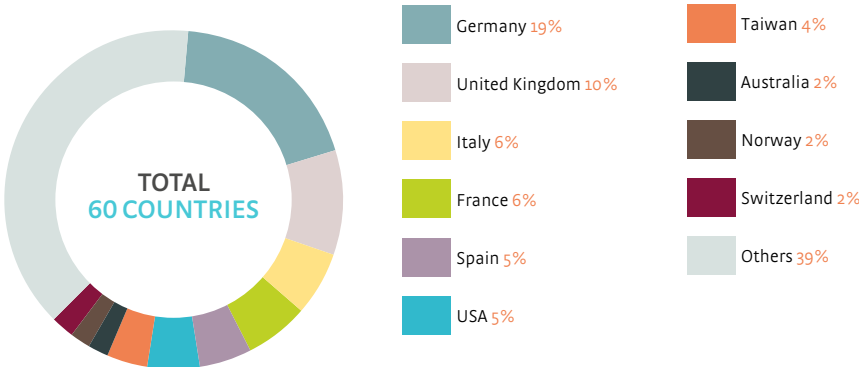

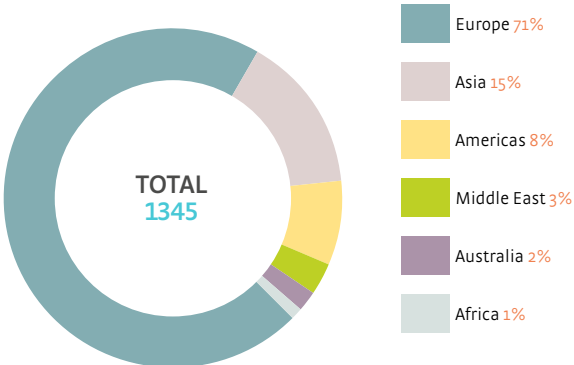
EACR CONGRESS REGISTRATION OVER THE YEARS (2002-2014)



TOP 10 COUNTRIES ATTENDING EACR23

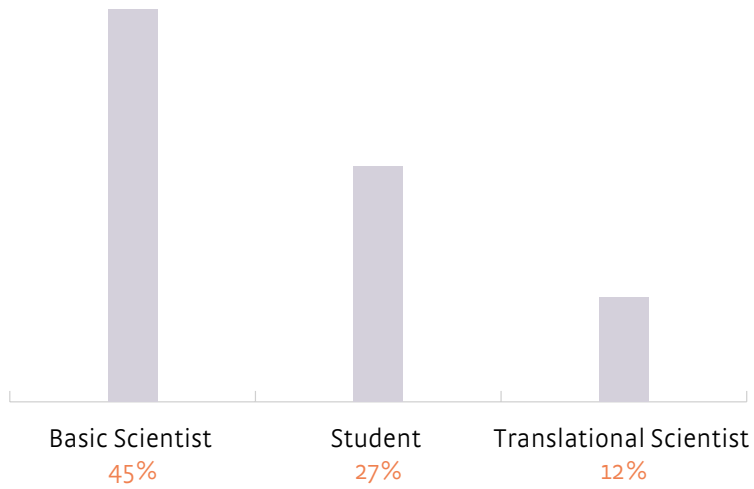


DEMOGRAPHICS BY GEOGRAPHIC REGION

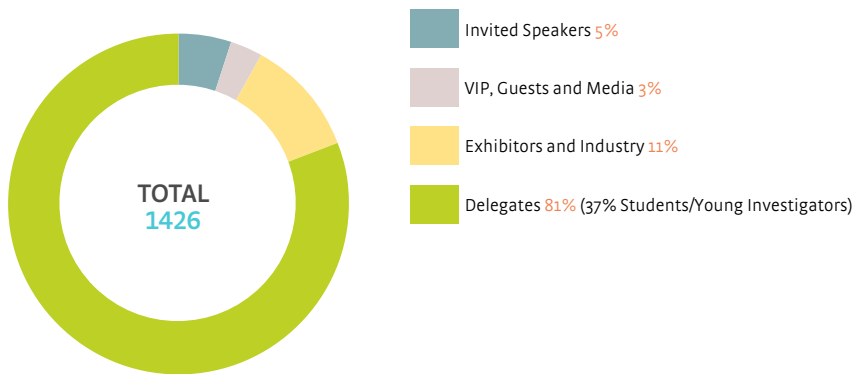


DEMOGRAPHICS BY PROFESSION

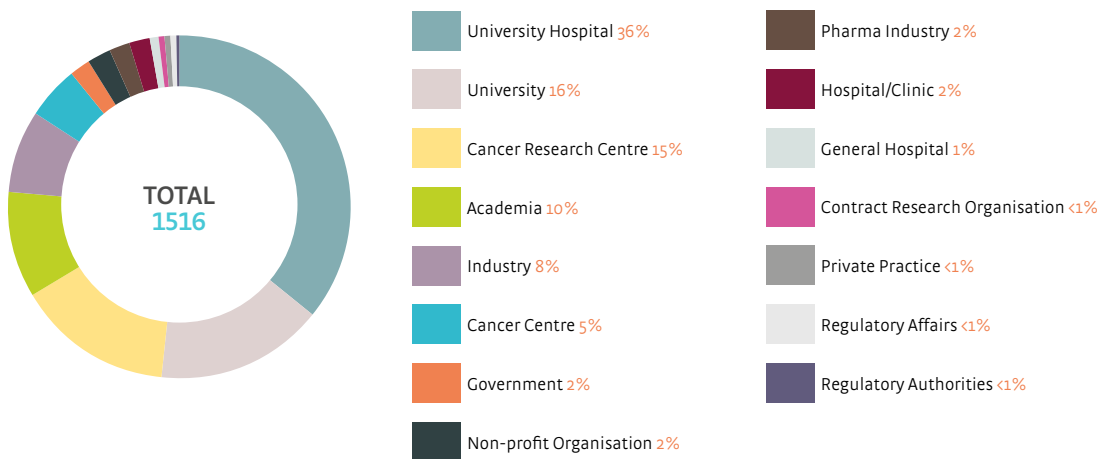
Top 3 professions



REGISTRATION TYPE



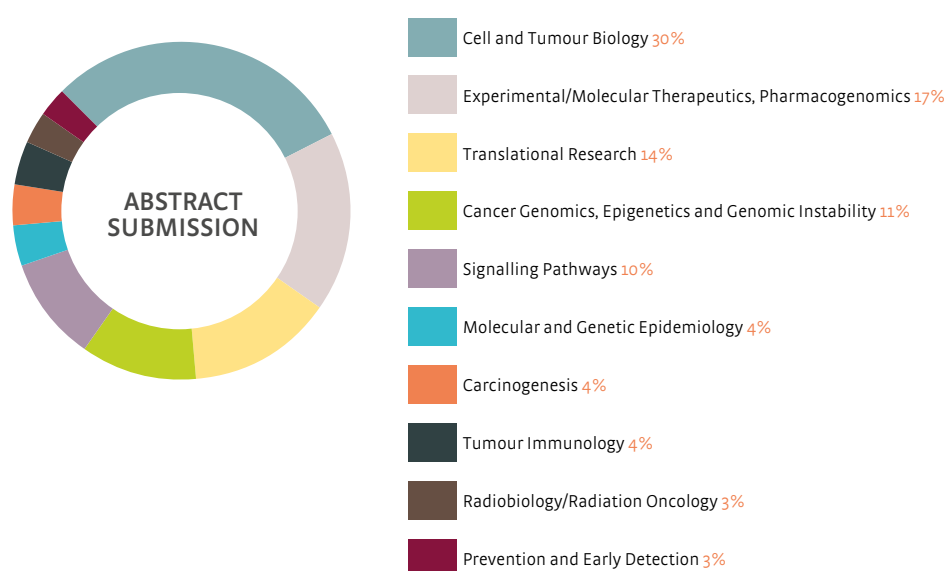
